Proposed Solar Farm – PA/2025/1201

Cllr McIntyre gave a brief update of the current 68 objections on the ABC Planning Portal and then opened it up to the public

Resident 1 - Legge Farm run an established tourist business within a rural location, where visitors enjoy peaceful walks in an idyllic location and are very concerned that the construction traffic will cause a lot of disruption 6 days a week for at least a year.

Resident 2 – Has concerns of flooding which has been raised by a number of people.

Hamstreet Resident – has major concerns about the increased traffic along Warehorne Road, as the road is very narrow, in places, and not designed for large HGV vehicles.

Resident 3 - Lives on Appledore Road and will have an access road built by her property where flooding already occurs.

Cllr Shilton – Suggested that anybody wishing to comment on the application should read the recent appeal review of the refused solar farm in Aldington

SMc – Having heard all comments he proposed that the PC object to the application, this was seconded by BH, JW abstained.
